






3rd Competition, (2nd online competition) For The Personnel from HR, Purchase, Marketing, Sales, Finance, Stores, & Admin,



Japanese Language Proficiency Test

--- 5 December 2021 ---

From the year 2002 onwards ABK – AOTS DOSOKAI, Tamilnadu Centre had been identified by the Consulate General of Japan, Chennai for coordinating in conducting the JAPANESE LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY TEST (JLPT).

The JLPT exam was successfully conducted on 5th December 2021 for 3500 examinees in two session (Forenoon & afternoon) at Vellammal Matriculation Hr. Sec. School, Chennai after the cancellation of three consecutive exams i.e. July 2020, December 2020 & July 2021. We also wish to inform that all the COVID precautionary measures like insisting the examinees, Proctors, Asst. Proctors, Control Room Staff to wear MASK throughout the exam, in the entrance we provided Sanitizers for cleaning the hands of the examinees, proctors, Asst Proctors to sanitized their hands before their entry into the examination hall and all were subjected to Thermal Scanner to ascertain their temperature. The entire venue / class rooms were sanitized and also air purifying machinery was utilized by us to keep the premises with the purified air.

Moreover we did not provide water points at the corridor to avoid crowding and have already requested the examinees to bring two water bottles for their use which was adhered by most of the examinees. And all the examinees were advised to stay in their classrooms after using the rest rooms to avoid crowding on the corridors during the breaks. We also collected the copy of the fully vaccinated certificate or RTPCR report and allowed the examinees to write the exam.

Some candidates took two levels, one in the forenoon and the other in the afternoon. Conducting of JLPT Exam in two shifts (forenoon & afternoon) has enabled the examinees to write two tests on a single day which was very well appreciated by the examinees and some of them made use of this opportunity.











The Japanese Language NAT -TEST

---- 12th December 2021 ----

The Japanese Language NAT-TEST is an examination that measures the Japanese language ability of students who are not native Japanese speakers. The tests are separated by difficulty (Q1 to Q5) and general ability is measured in three categories: Grammar/Vocabulary, Listening and Reading Comprehension. NAT Test is being held six times a year. ABK – AOTS DOSOKAI, Tamilnadu Centre in association with Senmon Kyouiku, Japan have been conducted the NAT TEST in Chennai held on 12th December 2021 at Meenakshi Sundararajan Engineering College, Chennai
