



--- 11 Oct 2020 ---










## Virtual tour to Japan's Village

--- 22 NOV 2020 ---




### On 3 Nov 2020 - SUPERSTITIOUS BELIEFS IN JAPAN




### On 15 Dec 2020- Session on Comedy played in of Japan



### On 24 NOV 2020 - GIFTING CULTURE


## Participating in the AOTS Webinar




