A Cultural, Technical & Trade Bridge Between Japan & India

Dear Readers of e Nihon Mon.

First, kindly accept our apologies in the delay in releasing this issue of E Nihonmon.

However the Good news is that we can include our hearty welcome to message to His Excellency Kojiro Uchiyama sama, the new Consul General of Japan to the Consulate General of Japan and Madame Uchiyama to Chennai.

2018 will be seeing closer cooperation between Japan and India in many fields like the few given below.

As part of its initiative to help the government of the Indian capital, the Japan International Cooperation Agency Since its first friendly agreement with Delhi in 2007 in areas such as culture, education, industry, tourism, environment and urban development and Fukuoka has been receiving trainees from Delhi for over a decade.

Japanese manufacturer Shinmaywa Industries and Indian defence firm Mahindra Defence have entered a partnership to promote the sale of Shinmaywa US-2i amphibious search-and-rescue/maritime surveillance aircraft to the Indian Navy.

Japan pledged on Thursday to provide India with yen loans of up to ¥100 billion (\$940 million) for the construction of Mumbai's subway system, and nearly ¥50 billion for other infrastructure projects. Ministry of Communications has launched the Cool EMS Service which will come into force from 29.03.2018. Cool EMS service is one-way service from Japan to India which allows customers in India to import Japanese food items for personal use which is allowed under Indian regulations. Food items will be carried by Japan Post in special cool boxes containing refrigerant to preserve the quality of the food items and addressee will collect them from Foreign Post office, Kotla Road, New Delhi in-person or through a messenger in the prescribed time frame. All other features like track and trace, etc of Express Mail Service (EMS) will be available for Cool EMS service as well.

We are sure, as being done during the last 44 tears, we, ABK AOTS DOSOKAI, will also continue our contribution for the Japan India Relations where ever we can.
