The Japanese Language NAT-TEST

The Japanese Language NAT - TEST is an examination that measures the Japanese language ability of students who are not native Japanese speakers. The tests are separated by difficulty (five levels) and general ability is measured in three categories: Grammar / Vocabulary, Listening and Reading Comprehension. The format of the exam and the types of questions are equivalent to those that appear on the Japanese Language Ability Test (JLPT). NAT Test is being held six times a year.

ABK – AOTS DOSOKAI, Tamilnadu Centre in association with Senmon Kyouiku, Japan have been conducted the NAT TEST in Chennai during April & June 2018 and the forthcoming NAT TEST is scheduled to be held on 12th August 2018.
