

In a remarkable initiative aimed at empowering underprivileged women and transforming their family lives, ABK-AOTS Dosokai Tamil Nadu Centre sponsored 10 Pink Auto Rickshaws for women auto drivers, providing training, licenses, and badges, thanks to the support of the Rotary Club. The official ceremony presenting the new autos took place on Thursday, 2<sup>nd</sup> November 2023, at the ABK-AOTS Dosokai Tamil Nadu Centre in Chennai.

The event was graced by the esteemed presence of His Excellency, Mr. Taga Masayuki, the Consul General of Japan in Chennai, who served as the Chief Guest. Mr. Masayuki handed over the keys and uniform coats to the Pink Auto women drivers, marking the beginning of their journey towards self-sufficiency.

Mr. G. Chandramohan, President of the Federation of AOTS Alumni Association of India (FAAAI), highlighted the pioneering nature of the Pink Auto Rickshaw Service, catering to women and children and operated by women drivers. The service is already operational in several cities across India, including Delhi, Surat, Mumbai, Jharkhand, Orissa, Assam, and Chennai, where the Rotary Club had previously presented over 100 pink autos to women. On 2<sup>nd</sup> November2023, these autos aim to challenge gender stereotypes and excel in a predominantly male-dominated profession, promoting women's safety in transportation as a symbol of empowerment.

Speaking at the event, our Founder Chairman, Mr. M.R. Ranganathan, passionately emphasized the transformative significance of the Pink Auto sponsorship. This sponsorship elevates the status of these drivers to that of an owner, increasing their social responsibility and behavior towards their customers. He also highlighted the urgent need in Japan for skilled Indians with Japanese language proficiency, with slogans on the back of these autos encouraging people to study Japanese and avail themselves of the sponsor's services.

Our President, Mr. C. Sriram, received the symbolic key from Bajaj, handed over by General Manager Mr. Venkatesh of Kings Autos. Ms. Shanthi Selvam and Mr. Selvam, two Rotarians who assisted in selecting these drivers and the project, were thanked by ABK-AOTS DOSOKAI and each honored with a shawl. The Consul General, while wishing the individuals well when handing over their uniform coats and keys, encouraged them to drive safely with the aim of serving society with dedication. Since the year 2002, ABK – AOTS DOSOKAI, Tamilnadu Centre has been designated by the Consulate General of Japan, Chennai, to coordinate and conduct the Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT).

The JLPT exam was successfully administered on 3rd December 2023 for 3270 examinees in two sessions (Forenoon & Afternoon) at Vellammal Matriculation Hr. Sec. School, Chennai.

Some candidates took two levels, one in the forenoon and the other in the afternoon. The decision to conduct the JLPT Exam in two shifts (forenoon & afternoon) allowed examinees to take two tests on a single day, a feature that was highly appreciated by the participants, and some of them took advantage of this opportunity.

# The Japanese Language "NAT EXAM" at Meenakshi Sundararajan Engineering College, Chennai

The Japanese Language NAT-TEST is an examination that measures the Japanese language ability of students who are not native Japanese speakers. 
