# --- 20<sup>th</sup> January 2024 ---


The webinar on techniques to handle conversation classes and tips and tricks to improve conversation in Japanese was expertly conducted by Sarojini Saro sensei.







# Special lecture during the WNF webinar on Current Trends in Industry 5.0 by AAAWI






#### **Shiru Shiru Club**







The Japanese Language "NAT EXAM" at Meenakshi Sundararajan Engineering College, Chennai

The Japanese Language NAT-TEST is an examination that evaluates the Japanese language proficiency of students who are not native Japanese speakers. The tests are divided into five levels of difficulty (Q5 to Q1), and general ability is assessed across three categories: Grammar/Vocabulary, Listening, and Reading Comprehension. The NAT Test is conducted six times a year. ABK – AOTS DOSOKAI, Tamil Nadu Centre, in collaboration with Senmon Kyouiku, Japan, has been organizing the NAT TEST in Chennai. The exams were
